- Pastor Shannon mentioned we should not have a careless attitude, let foxes spoil the root, let things distract us from our relationship with God.

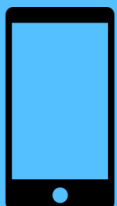
Which of these do you think is most common among fellow Christians? How do we support one another to live above reproach?
