- Most times, we are one step away from the greatest victory in our lives, but we will never know if we allow it to derail us. What is/has derailed you? What do you need to make a decision on?

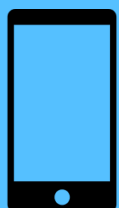
**Start praying.** Be bold and pray with power.
